ECON 298, ECON 299, and ECON 602 FORM

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Econ 298: Directed Group Study for Graduate Students

1-4 Units

Prerequisite: Consent of instructor. Seminars for group study of selected topics which will vary from year to year. For 2 or more students. Group study for econometrics paper requirement.

Econ 602: Individual Study for Doctoral Students

1-8 Units

(Prior to Advancing to Candidacy)

Individual study in consultation with the major field advisor, intended to provide an opportunity for qualified graduate students to prepare themselves for the various examinations required of candidates for the Ph.D. A student will be permitted to accumulate a maximum of 16 units of 602.

Econ 299: Supervised Independent Study and Research

1-12 Units

(After Advancing to Candidacy or special cases)

Open to those students who have passed the qualifying examination and who are engaged in research for the thesis, and, in special cases, with consent of the instructor in charge, to graduate students who desire to do special work in a particular field. Students may take up to 12 units of 299 per semester while all other students may only take up to 6 units per semester.

A <u>faculty member must to agree to supervise</u> the course, whether 298, 602, or 299, by signing below. Note: If 298 or 299 are taken as a field class (such as Health Economics and History of Economic Thought), an outline and schedule of the work to be completed by the student as well as a reading list must be submitted with this form.
